

ORDINANCE NO. 2352

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF ERLANGER IN KENTON COUNTY KENTUCKY, RENAMING A PORTION OF ALICE STREET TO JACK SCHEBEN DRIVE.**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ERLANGER, IN KENTON COUNTY, KENTUCKY AS FOLLOWS:

**Section 1.0 – Street Renamed**

That portion of Alice Street in the City of Erlanger that extends in a generally southwest direction from Stevenson Road is hereby renamed “Jack Scheben Drive,” in recognition of the more than a half a century of service by Jack Scheben to the City in general and particularly to the Fire/EMS Department.

**Section 2.0 – Provisions Severable**

The provisions of this ordinance are severable; and the invalidity of any provision of this ordinance shall not affect the validity of any other provision thereof; and such other provisions shall remain in full force and effect as long as they remain valid in the absence of those provisions determined to be invalid.

**Section 3.0 – Conflicting Ordinances Repealed**


All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.
