

A Notary Public is a public officer constituted by law to serve the public in non-controversial matters usually concerned with estates, deeds, powers-of-attorney, and foreign and international business. A notary's main function is to administer oaths and affirmations, take affidavits and statutory declarations, and to witness and authenticate the execution of certain classes of documents.

The City of Erlanger has eight (8) notary publics on staff for the convenience of the public, Monday-Friday from 7:00 a.m.-6:00 p.m. There is not a fee for this service. However, a picture ID is requested.
