PART THREE: Illegal Drug Use

In recent years, drug usage has become common in our society. The Erlanger Police Department recognizes that it would be impossible to hire anyone who has not experimented with some illegal drug(s). However, it is important that we are aware of your past and current use of **illegal drugs**. This includes prescription drugs, whether or not it was prescribed to you or to that of another and in which you abused or used without the need for the medication.

Let's discuss what is meant by use. With pills we are interested in the number of times you have ingested. With drugs, such as cocaine, we are interested in the number of times you have smoked, snorted, ingested, or injected the drug. With marijuana, the number of times you have smoked (this includes taking a "hit", "toke" or "puff") or consumed by mouth. Each **separate instance** of illegal drug use, regardless of the quantity used or consumed, is to be considered as **"one time used"**.

We are interested in the beginning and ending date(s) and the manner of consumption. If it was smoked, snorted, injected or consumed by any other manner, you **MUST** explain how it was used. When asked to give the number of times that you used a particular illegal drug, you must give the **absolute maximum number of times** you used the drug. If you intentionally underestimate your drug usage you will appear deceptive when questioned during the polygraph examination. If you are not sure of the number of times you may have used the drug(s), then state the absolute number of times you could have used the drug(s).
